

## TF 1-501 PCI/PCC CHECKLIST

(This checklist is used in conjunction with the TACSOP and the Geronimo Standards SOP. Everyone Will have someone checking them. CSM Checks BN CDR, 1SG checks his Commander, etc.)

### Worn

### Appearance
