SUBJECT: Safety and Occupational Health Policy Statement (GC Policy #22-32)

1. Our safety and health programs are focused on a safe and healthy workplace for all. Awareness and close attention to safety and health matters must always be foremost in our minds and demonstrated by our actions.
2. Within USARAK we employ safety and occupational health standards consistent with those provided for under the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA). Also, the Civilian Resource Conservation Committee (CRCP), which I chair, meets quarterly to discuss injury/accident trends, causes, corrective measures, potential problem areas, and policy. Membership on this committee consists of representatives from major USARAK elements, tenant activities, and the local union. There are open discussions of safety and health problems and their remedies.
3. Along with the members of the CRCP committee, I wholeheartedly support the USARAK safety and occupational health program and expect enthusiastic support of every leader along with the full cooperation of every employee. Everyone is challenged to find new ways to reduce costs associated with occupational injuries. As a minimum, I encourage supervisors to identify those individuals who have demonstrated histories of repeated accidents and injuries and provide counseling and closer supervision of them and their work.
