SUBJECT: Delegated Examining Authority

1. Reference:

a. ASA(M&RA) memorandum, dated 17 Jul 01, SAB (Encl).


b. USARPAC, Civilian Personnel Director memorandum, dated 21 Aug 01, SAB (Encl).

2. Reference 1.b. authorizes the Director of the Civilian Personnel Operations Center (CPOC) to approve positions for examination.

3. I hereby grant the Delegated Examining Office of the Pacific Region CPOC, the authority to examine applicants, establish competitor inventories (registers), and issue certificates of eligibility in all occupational series and grade levels except for those that are covered under the Administrative Careers With America, Administrative Judge, or positions covered under the Department of the Army centralized recruitment process for certain professional medical positions (MEDCELL). Recruitment options through MEDCELL must be exhausted or approval received from MEDCELL prior to opening registers or announcements for positions. Exercise of examining authority must be in conformance with the requirements of law, regulation, the OPM Delegated Examining Unit Operations Handbook, and this authority.

SUBJECT: Delegated Examining Authority

The Department of Defense has revised the business process for the expansion of delegated examining authority at Department of the Army delegated examining units (Office of Personnel Management now uses the term Examining Offices). Currently our examining offices are required to list the title, series, and grade of each position they wish to add to their delegated examining authority, and send that request through Headquarters, Department of the Army to Department of Defense for approval.

The Department of Defense has now delegated approval authority to the components, and we are re delegating it. With this memorandum you are authorized to approve requests for additions to the delegated examining authority of your examining offices. You may redelegate this authority. Assure that the additions to the delegated examining authority are documented in the examining office.

This delegation does not include the authority to examine for any Administrative Careers With America positions (Enclosure 1) or Administrative Law Judge positions.
