

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Registration of Motorcycles, Motor Scooters and Mopeds (GC Policy # 22-34)

1. Completion of an Army approved motorcycle safety course will be a prerequisite for the operation and registration of motorcycles, motor scooters and mopeds (street legal) on U. S. Army Alaska (USARAK) installations.
2. Proof of completion of the motorcycle safety course must be presented to the Provost Marshal's Office as part of the vehicle registration process. Registration must occur within five days after completion of the motorcycle safety course.
3. As an exception to policy, individuals may operate a motorcycle, motor scooter or moped on-post prior to completion of the motorcycle safety course if required to do so as part of the motorcycle safety course curriculum or for the purpose of storing the vehicle.
4. Commanders and supervisors will ensure that soldiers and employees are informed of this requirement. Verifying compliance will be part of all units' pre-holiday safety inspections.
