MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Recreational Access for Fort Richardson (FRA Garrison Commander Policy #24-20)

1. Civilians and military personnel requesting Recreational Access to Fort Richardson property south of the Glenn Highway may visit or call the Fort Richardson visitors center @ 384-2916 to ascertain which training areas are available for recreational use. Civilians and military personnel requesting Recreational Access to Fort Richardson property north of the Glen Highway must be an authorized DoD ID card/FRA Installation Pass holder or be on the FRA Installation Access Roster (See FRA Garrison Commander Policy #24-15 and #24-16) and must visit the Fort Richardson visitors center to ascertain which training areas are available for recreational use. At the Visitors Center, the requestor must log in with the following information:

- a. Full name
- b. Number of people in requestor's party
- c. Training area to be visited
- d. Type of recreational activity

2. All recreational visitors must log out of FRA training areas by 2200 hours on the day of use.

3. This authorization for access is subject to change based upon current Force Protection Condition (FPCON) levels. Access can be denied to installation pass holders at Force Protection Delta or anytime the FRA Garrison Commander determines an increased level of threat.
