RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS

1. QUESTION: We have reviewed the amendment, revised scope of work and additional Government Furnished Information (GFI). Information concerning well construction details (well depth, casing diameter, and screen interval) is not available for the following: (ANSWERS IN BOLD TEXT)

MP2C **These are 1 and ¼ inch black iron pipe, 2 inch screen, 12 to 15**
MP3C **foot depth.**

AP7509 **2 inch PVC, 20 foot depth, and screen interval at 10 feet.**

AP8780 a/k/a MW1
AP8781 a/k/a MW2 **See added GFI**
AP8782 a/k/a MW3

AP7222 **These 6 wells are 2 inch PVC, 20 foot depth, screen interval average**

NOTE: If proposed bidder cannot find information on wells, the assumption should be made that they are 2 inch diameter wells.

2. QUESTION: Please clarify whether analytical costs are to be included in the Mob and Demob Tasks (CLIN 0001AE and CLIN 0001AM) or rather in site-specific sampling tasks (CLIN 0001AA, CLIN 0001AB, CLIN 0001AC, CLIN 0001AD and CLIN 0001AJ).

ANSWER: Analytical costs are located in site-specific sampling tasks.

3. QUESTION: It is our understanding that all IDW water must be transported to the IDW water treatment facility at building 3489. Are there specific times as to when water can or can not be dropped off there? If so, are there additional options for IDW water during periods when water can not be accepted at the IDW water treatment facility?

ANSWER: IDW can be dropped off at virtually anytime with prior advance coordination with IDW Facility Contractor. This dialogue can occur post award, but no real restrictions exist on time/date.

4. QUESTION: CLIN 0001AP, Reporting for tasks 8, 9, and 12. This task states that results for Fall sampling at the Coal Storage Site shall be reported. However, CLIN 0001AI, Fall Sampling at Coal Storage Yard, has been removed.

ANSWER: Disregard all references to the Coal Storage Yard as it is no longer a task.

5. QUESTION: Response to Question 9 in Amendment 3. It is unclear as to which task this question and answer are referring to.

ANSWER: Optional Task 2 CLIN 0002AB.

6. QUESTION: Response to Question 11 in Amendment 3. The answer to this question states that air rotary drilling is only acceptable for landfill well installation. Does this imply that air rotary drilling is acceptable or required?

ANSWER: At landfill, air rotary is required because of site specific conditions.

7. QUESTION: Response to Question 38 in Amendment 3. It is unclear as to which task this question and answer are referring.

ANSWER: Optional Task 2 CLIN 0002AB.

8. QUESTION: Is the number of soil samples required to be analyzed by the specified methods 5 total or 5 per well at the 5-foot intervals collected to 25 feet?

ANSWER: 5-foot intervals collected to 25 feet

9. QUESTION: In Amendment 3, the answer given to Question 61 states that a CDQR is not required, however Section 3.11 of the referenced Work Plan/QAPP (GFI "F") does require a CDQR. Please clarify.

ANSWER: Correct, it is required for this site. Therefore, the answer is Yes, follow CDQR requirements in the Work Plan/QAPP.

10. QUESTION: Please verify that the data emanating from the Landfill monitoring must meet the requirements of the Work Plan/QAPP referenced in GFI "F".

ANSWER: Yes

11. QUESTION: In Section 4 of the Scope of Work, please clarify the required laboratory analysis. There is no such method as SW EPA8270-SIM. SW846 contains no GC/MS-SIM methods. EPA 8270 is a full scan method, SIM is not. There is no published GC/MS-SIM method for PAHs, they are modified methods, with each laboratory

having a different version. SW-846 GC/MS methods require that the instrument be tuned and present criteria that the instrument must meet in order to run samples. With SIM analysis, there is no tune. In addition, there are other significant differences. Therefore, do you want a SW-846 method (8310B or 8270C) or a modified SIM method based on laboratory Standard operating procedures?

ANSWER: SW-8270C

12. QUESTION: Should we include travel costs for the optional tasks in CLIN 001AS?

ANSWER: The only additional travel that would be required for an optional task would be additional per diem, car rental, etc. The work would be done at the same time Contractor was on site performing base tasks. Additional travel expenses would be itemized separately in CLIN001AS. The labor would be included in the cost estimate for the optional task itself.

13. QUESTION: Are there any limitations on the length of the sampling day, for example, does the investigative-derived waste need to be delivered to the disposal location each day, and if so, by a specified time?

ANSWER: IDW can be dropped off at virtually anytime with prior advance coordination with IDW Facility Contractor. This dialogue can occur post award, but no real restrictions exist on time/date.

14. QUESTION: Under Option Task 2, regarding the second replacement well, will a 10-foot section of screen be utilized and set somewhere between 15 and 125 feet below grade, depending upon site conditions?

ANSWER: Yes. Assume 55 feet for costing purposes.

15. QUESTION: Do Davis/Bacon wages apply to the drillers or surveyors?

ANSWER: Service Contract Act will cover this contract but Davis/Bacon wages should be paid when applicable.

16. QUESTION: Will we be able to gain access to the base to hand deliver our proposals on the day that they are due, simply by signing in at the visitor center and having the appropriate identification, or are other means of advance coordination necessary?

ANSWER: There should not be a problem with access to the installation unless a different threat level is enforced. If access is denied notify Jim Holloway at 384-7104 or another representative of this office, explain you are to drop off a proposal, and arrangements will be made to meet at the front gate.

17. QUESTION: Is the answer to question 51 from the original set of questions, it is stated that ... "2-inch fine steel" [will be utilized to construct the wells in Option Task 2]. Does this refer to stainless steel?

ANSWER: Yes, should be stainless.

18. QUESTION: Is this solicitation a stand alone RFP or is it under the GSA Contracts? We want to make sure we priced this RFP properly whether it's using our Forward Pricing Rate Agreement (FPRA) or with GSA Contract pricing.

ANSWER: This is an unrestricted requirement.
