

(i) This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. (ii) This request for quotation (RFQ) number is **W912CZ-04-T-0059**. (iii) This RFQ and the provisions and clauses incorporated are those in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC) 2001-18. (iv) This acquisition is 100 percent small business set aside, in regards to size standard of 500 employees. The applicable NAICS is **423110** (v) This RFQ contains two line items:

1. **CLIN 0001** - The following specifications are for an ATV rescre sled to help provide support for any type rescue that may be made in a remote area. This sled will have the capability to be used with a snowmobile and an ATV. It will be equipped with both wheels and skis so that it can be used on any condition that may be needed:

1.0 Sled Specifications and Dimensions

- 1.01 Outside Dimensions 103”L x 34 ½”W X 16”D
- 2.01 The body shall be made of heavy duty polyethylene.
- 3.01 The frame shall be 1 ¼” steel frame that is powder coated black.

2.0 Features of the sled

- 2.01 Color of the sled shall be black.
- 2.02 Front canopy shall be Red and also be removable.
- 2.03 The rear seat shall be red and removable
- 2.04 The hitch style shall be 2” ball coupler.
- 2.05 Seatbelts provided with the rear seat when attached to the sled.

3.0 Wheel Specifications and standards

- 3.01 High speed tapered roller bearings.
- 3.02 Greasable wheel hubs.
- 3.03 18” Knobby flotation tires.
- 3.04 Have a ski conversion kit accessory
- 3.05 Also be able to convert to sleigh conversion kit.

4.0 Accessories

- 4.01 Canvas cover for sled shall be colored Black.
- 4.02 Canvas cover will be specially made for the sled and also have a Velcro center for patient access.
- 4.03 Stretcher will be an aluminum frame material with wheels on one end and legs on the other. Also have the capability to raise head of stretcher to position of comfort and tail of the stretcher in the trelenberg position. The stretcher will have a 1-2” vinyl pad the same size of the stretcher for patient comfort. Backboard will meet size and width requirements of the aluminum stretcher.
